Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) requires that we gain verifiable consent for your child to participate in our program.

We are asking for your permission to retain your child's information (name, email, hometown, grade level, and school) and adult sponsor's (teacher, parent/guardian) name and email in order to track student participation, accept student submissions, notify winners, and distribute awards. If you consent, we may use your child's name in program-related outreach.

To participate, your child must provide his/her personal information (first and last name, email, age, hometown, and school); his/her project; and an adult sponsor's first and last name and email. If your child is under the age of 13, the information collected will be kept confidential in compliance with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA).

The War Through Children's Eyes platform is the sole owner of all the information that is collected.

- The personal information provided by the child is used to track program participation, accept student projects, notify program winners, and distribute awards.
- Only with parent/guardian consent, the child's name, or school's name may be used to promote the program. This includes, but is not limited to, outreach via social media, websites, organizational literature, and at events.
- This platform will not require a child to disclose more information than is reasonably necessary to participate in the program.
- No information will be disclosed to third parties.
- The parent can review the child's personal information, ask to have it deleted, and refuse to allow any further collection or use of the child's information.
